- You are Benched!** 6 benches you will find, Nathan Scott keep in mind, take off your boots, or pet the cat, you get 3 points in your hat!
- Harry and Family** were seen here strolling, while the press were a-trolling. If you find this place you will see, many many many trees! Walk around and take your picture with Harry, Meghan and Archie hiding nearby!
- George Mills** gave the land, and was the first to rest there, now ain't that grand! It's one of oldest churches on the Isle, go there and see history to make you smile PS. The Holy Three! Take pics of one of the resting places of noted pioneers buried here: William Towner (1840-1925), Richard John (died 1892), Alice Horth (née Wain) 1858-1945, and George Pearkes (1888-1984), a Canadian Army General who was awarded the Victoria Cross and later became Lieutenant-Governor of British Columbia.
- WW2:** Not long ago during the 2nd World War, was a place soldiers were cared for, find the sculpture to pay respect, history we cannot neglect. **HINT:** It's near where the airplanes fly and is not far from a famous church on the same street. The sculpture in dedication is representative of a Cooper's hawk for its agility and prowess in flight, resiliency, beauty and the fact that it's a ferocious predator.
